Effective social skills are critical to emotional and cognitive development. Social skills deficiency are one of the central features of those with autism spectrum disorders and other

disabilities. Making and fostering relationships is difficult and challenging when individuals lack these skills. It has been found that when children do not have good friendship skills, the negative effects are long lasting and affect cognitive social and emotional development.

However, typically developing children acquire social skills such as: problem solving, conflict resolution, respecting the ideas of others, cooperation and team work without direct instruction. Positive social interactions promote a sense of well being, healthy relationships and a sense of belonging. S.T.A.R. Summer Camp's goal is for children with disabilities to generalize social skills taught and practiced at camp into their daily life. The summer camp will also provide academic support as identified through the camper's Individual Education Plan.

S.T.A.R Summer Camp 2024

Two Weeks: July 8-19, 2024 (ages 3+)

If necessary, all camp experiences and teacher/student staffing will be adjusted and developed according to age population and severity of disability.

Staffed with Special Education Teachers experienced in Autism and other disabilities. Low student-teacher ratios.

Cost per camper is \$375.00* per week. Non-refundable fee is due with application no later than June 1, 2024.

Lunch, snacks, drinks and transportation to be provided by parent/guardian.

The Camp Director will review all applications. Not all applicants will be admitted.
